#### Winter Wildlife Tracking

Join Heather Simpson of Hands on Nature in Berlin, MA for a 4-week session. Following animal's tracks can teach us a lot about who lives in our woods and their behavior. Students will search for animal tracks and identify which animals have been active and what they were up to. Students will explore the woods around the school to look for tracks and other signs from animals such as raccoons, foxes, coyotes, owls, turkeys, white-tailed deer and more! Please note, classes will be outside so appropriate dress is required.

#### **Blue Blocks Free Play**




